Our camp instructors are fully trained, have a passion for inspiring a love of nature in children, and are dedicated to creating a fun learning environment for all campers!

Children may only be registered in a maximum of **two** sessions.

Fee: \$250 per child per week. Short week is prorated to \$200. For children aged 7 to 12 (must be between 7 and 12 by the first day of camp)

Theme B – Planet Savers: Camper favourites such as canoeing, pond study, fishing, and archery as well as hikes, games, crafts, and activities exploring ways to be a "Planet Saver" and reduce our ecological footprints.

Camp Bitobig Schedule

Cohorts will have a staggered start and camp will run from 8:40am to 3:40pm or 9:00am to 4:00pm depending on the group. Families will be notified of times for their cohort the week before camp. There will be no bussing this year; all pick ups and drop offs are at the Nature Chalet (2309 South Bay Road).

Friday is "Pizza Day" - Lunch, snacks and beverages must be provided by you on the other days of the week.
