a) Permission under Section 28/29 Report

b) Regulation Review Committee Report

Bailey Chabot provided an update on the recent Regulation Review Committee meeting. This was the second part of a hearing for this application. The Committee recommended that permission for development in a floodplain at 0 Cook St, Coniston be denied.
